Each family is asked to donate 4 pies or desserts and 2 loaves of bread. According to the Osage County Health Department, NO cream pies are to be brought to the hall for serving the public. Lemon and pumpkin pies are not considered cream pies, so they would be okay. Cupcakes and Angel food cakes will work as well. Regular cakes have a tendency to dry out. Handmade items, such as tea towels, pillow cases, throw pillows, arts, crafts, baked items, berries, jelly, garden vegetables and plants are needed for the country store.

We will begin working at the Civic League Center on Thursday, continuing into Friday, Saturday, Sunday of course, and cleaning on Monday. We will begin work each day at 8:00. Lunches will be provided each day with snacks on Monday. Any help would be appreciated.

THURSDAY: Bake cookies

FRIDAY: Prepare roasts, make breads and brownies, and set up dining area

SATURDAY: Baking a variety of items for country store, slicing beef, peeling cucumbers (if we have some), chopping onions, shredding cabbage, etc.
Outside stands cleaned and set up as much as possible.

MONDAY: Final cleanup of all stands, pavilion and hall.
