

A NOTE FROM YOUR PASTOR ...

Dear friends in Christ,

First of all, I'd like to express my sincerest thanks to all of the St. Cecilia Parishioners who worked so very hard in preparation for, during and after last Sunday's Parish Picnic. Many of you stepped up to the challenge again and again throughout the day in order to provide great hospitality and wonderful food to all of our guests (1494 adults, 82 kids). You should take pride in a job well done even in spite of the summer heat and the flash flooding that happened just a couple of weeks ago. It is very heartening to see so many of you so generously give of yourselves and work together for the good of our parish community. That having been said, to those parishioners who chose not to participate in the annual Parish Picnic for whatever reasons, please examine your consciences and make a firm resolve to participate more fully in next year's picnic activities.

Secondly, for St. Thomas parishioners, I want to let you know that during this past week, a contract with Industrial Enterprises Incorporated (IEI) was approved to replace the hot water boiler and HVAC control system in church. As I have mentioned to you in this forum, various components of the boiler system which provides heat in church have begun to fail and because of the age of the Weil Mclain boiler, replacement parts are no longer available.

Although it is the middle of summer and heat is the last thing one really wants to think about, I would hate for us to find ourselves in the middle of winter with a catastrophic boiler failure on our hands. After extensive consultation and review of the current system and heating needs of the church building, it was recommended that two smaller high efficiency propane boilers (94%) be installed. It has been estimated that the current boiler is obtaining no more than 60% efficiency at best. Coupled with an updated HVAC control system, we will be able to better limit the very wide temperature and humidity swings that our church building experiences, variances that take their toll on the plaster and woodwork in church. The overall cost for the boiler and control system replacement is \$30,020. A grant from the Schwartze Foundation was received for half of that amount. Your support of this project is greatly appreciated.

Finally, this coming week is the Totus Tuus summer camp in St. Thomas and St. Cecilia Parishes. As of the printing of this bulletin, <u>57</u> children from both parishes have been registered. Parents: please encourage your children to bring their water bottles. The Totus Tuus high school program begins at 7:00 pm on Sunday evening at St. Cecilia Parish Center; the Totus Tuus program for younger grades begins Monday morning. On Wednesday, July 22nd, there will be a 5:30 p.m. potluck meal for all parishioners and Totus Tuus participants at the St. Thomas cafeteria. Kindly note, because of Totus Tuus, Masses on Monday-Friday will be at 11:00 am each day at St. Thomas.


